His spring and summer collection 81 will be presented in Windhoek by Inge Gramann on Wednesday November 26, and Thursday, 27, in the Moringa Room.

Sixty garments will be shown by seven local models with Jean Rees as compère.

Errol's exotic sister, Gloria, will be in Windhoek for the occasion and can also be consulted for special garments, made to measure. She is much sought after as a photographic model, and also recently played a role in the musical "South Pacific" in Cape Town.

Tickets cost R15 per person with a three course dinner included; proceeds are in aid of the "Alte Feste" Lions Club, and tickets can be obtained at Inge's Boutique and Salon Ohle.
